Bent Water Brewing Company is seeking a warehouse / packaging associate to support beer production in our Lynn, MA brewery. The ideal candidate is an enthusiastic, skilled, self-motivated, communicative individual who will report directly to the Asst. Director of Operations and be responsible for assisting in the day-to-day activities within the brewery's warehouse and packaging departments. This candidate loves craft beer passionately, is detail oriented, and is both responsible and hard working – just like the rest of the Bent Water Team! Extensive production experience is not necessary; Bent Water will train the right candidate.

Job Responsibilities, including but not limited to:

- Help organize dry storage and rotate / restock finished goods in cold storage
- Assist in counting inventory, such as finished goods and packaging materials
- Pick and prep any outgoing orders for both core delivery and distribution
- Assist by scanning kegs onto the drivers trucks in KegID each morning
- Thoroughly understand the life cycle of our kegs and how to appropriately scan kegs at each point in the process using KegID and other QR Code apps
- Load / unload trucks as they arrive
- Process distribution load sheets in brewery software (Encompass) after pickup
- Assist on the packaging line, as needed
- Set up the keg washer
- Wash kegs and replace chemicals as needed
- Repair kegs, as needed
- Prepare can dunnage appropriately - freight ready
- Organize and clean up the outside areas
- Monitor can recycling and coordinate with drivers for removal, as needed

Qualifications:

- Must be 21+
- Warehouse experience preferred, but not required
- Forklift certification or ability to become certified
- An interest and general knowledge of craft beer
- Positive outlook, attitude, and astute problem solving skills
- Ability to work unsupervised while maintaining safety and quality standards
- Attention to detail, and strong mechanical aptitude a major plus
- Able to work in warm, cold, indoor and outdoor conditions
- Ability to frequently stand, walk, stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl and climb
- Ability to lift 55lbs and move 100lbs
- A team player who is willing to help others when needed
- Available to work early mornings and some late afternoons, especially in the summer
